

Adding/Updating Endnote filters when you don't have admin rights to C:/

Although comprehensive, if the Endnote list of import filters doesn't have your database search Endnote to see if the filter is available to download.

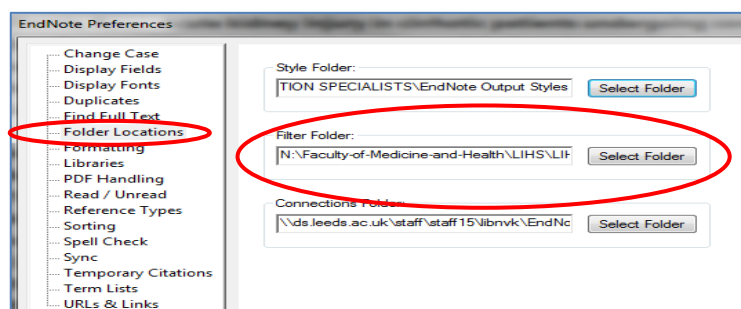

Save it in the **Endnote filter** folder

On a networked PC without admin permissions to the C: drive, do the following.

1. In your personal drive, create a folder called Endnote filters
2. Open Endnote and select **Edit preferences** and click **Folder locations**

3. Change the file path of the **Filter folder** selecting the location of the Endnote style folder you created. Select the folder and click **apply, OK**



4. Download the filter from Endnote and store it here. You will still be able to access all the default endnote import filters

To restore the original settings follow the instructions and change the folder location to C:\Program Files\Endnote styles
